Financial Update

You could say that another piece of good news is that the Camp was in a good position financially when the decision was made to cancel programs for this summer.

However, summer camp fees make up the majority of our income budget each year. With the cancellation of camp for this summer and refunding all camper fees we are expecting to see a \$30,000 deficit by the end of this year. This is with reducing all expenses (utilities, supplies, projects) to a bare minimum.

We are preparing an appeal to ask for “A Helping Hand” to reduce our expected deficit. Would you prayerfully consider how you can help us through until next spring? Your donation will provide funds needed to keep things going and prepare for next summer without having a deficit in the budget.

Adult Retreats

As we look forward to the fall, circumstances require that the Board of Directors continue to make tough decisions. Most recently, the Board voted to cancel the Ladies Retreat, Men’s Retreat and Senior Day that were scheduled to take place in September.

The Board also made decisions about other events that traditionally take place in August & September and the groups affected have been contacted. They will continue to look forward and make decisions about the rest of the year as information from authorities becomes available.

We know that these decisions are disappointing to many people and the Board is grateful for everyone’s patience and understanding as they strive to make prayerful and appropriate decisions.
