


## Adult Retreat Programs



## New Dining Room Update

Much of this past year has been spent bringing awareness to churches and individuals about the second phase of the Retreat Center. This new area that will seat over 300 people will be a great asset during the summer and all throughout the year.

Right now we are excited to say we have just about reached the 10% mark of the total funds needed to complete the building. With plans to build once half the money is raised we can say we are 20% toward the start of construction.

At this point 9 different churches have come on board to help financially with this project. That means we still have a lot of churches that need to prayerfully consider how they can help. One of our smaller churches just contacted me this morning and said they were sending \$5000 now and will send \$1000 each year for the next 5 years! Wow! Way to go!!
