

New Dining Room Update

We are getting closer and closer! We are half way into our \$2 Challenge campaign with churches gathering \$2 per week from individuals and families that put their donation in a box with a plate that pictures the camp's new dining room. Since this campaign started, the building fund has grown from just under \$250,000 to now nearly \$400,000. Our goal has been to have at least 50% of the funds for this million dollar project by 2020 when we hope to start building.

In order for this to happen we need everyone and every church on board and giving. Please continue to encourage the \$2 per week offerings by announcing it regularly. Also, if your congregation is only giving to the general fund please consider making additional contributions this year to the camp's building fund. Almost half of our nearly 60 churches have yet to come on board with this project and we could really use your help! To the 30 something churches who have been helping with general giving and this project we say thank you very much and we can't wait to see how God will use this facility in the near future.
